The Welcome Centre is an initiative of Welcome to Australia, and aims to be a safe place of refuge where every day Australians and new arrivals are given a space to interact and build relationships. We also provide support through the programs below as well as volunteer opportunities; food donations and emergency relief (to people of refugee and asylum seeker background); social support; free internet cafe and printer.

Take the 251, 252, 253 and 254 buses from the city to Stop 9 Hawker Street (just past the train line) and look for The Welcome Centre sign on the corner.
